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## GENERAL INFORMATION

- > A physician's order is not required for these tests.
- > Come directly to the hospital laboratory.
- > Pay for testing by cash, check, Visa® or MasterCard®.
- > This service is available Monday through Saturday from 7 am to 6 pm. No appointment is necessary. (See back of brochure for testing locations and hours.)
- > The results will be mailed directly to you, and you are encouraged to share them with your health care provider.
- > Most test results will be mailed to you within three to five working days.
- > Anyone under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- > A pathologist will review critical test results and a list of physicians in the area will be provided upon request.

Testing is performed by HealthEast Medical Laboratory, licensed and accredited by federal and regulatory agencies, ensuring accurate and precise laboratory results.

Reference ranges are provided for certain tests and are designed to help you interpret results. A normal result does not guarantee that you do not need medical attention; likewise, an abnormal result may not necessarily be abnormal for you. Your complete medical history must be considered.

You are responsible for contacting a physician regarding your test results, if necessary.
