### Please bring patients in through the ED.

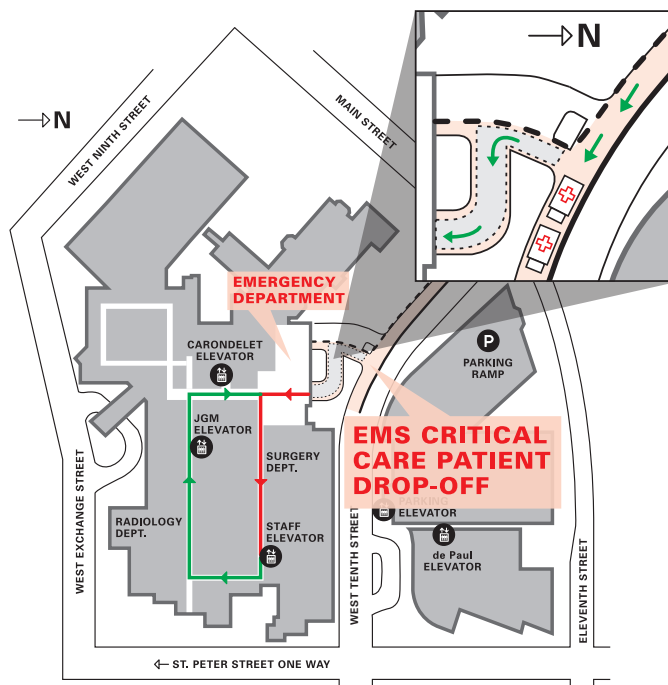
When transporting **cardiac level one patients** you will continue to access the cath lab using the staff elevators through the Surgery Department.
